Working with Phyl Smith, a librarian in Wintringham's home town of Grimsby, they have since discovered a wealth of historical firsts, including the actual leaflet Wintringham wrote that led the prosecution case in the infamous treason trial of the Communist Party leadership in 1925, as well as additional evidence that, in the summer of 1936, Wintringham was already propagating the idea of an 'international legion' to fight for Republican Spain. Churchill coined his own expletive as in 'I refuse to be Wintringhamed.' Hemingway wrote his only play, *Fifth Column*, based on Wintringham and his lover, a supposed 'Trotskyite spy.' Photographs show Orwell and Wintringham together in 1940 training for guerrilla warfare to resist a Nazi invasion.
